Some Rules About Adjectives

Adjectives that end in -o are masculine and describe boys.

Roberto es cómico.

Adjectives that end in -e are neutral and don't change for gender at all.

Roberto es inteligente.

María es inteligente.

Adjectives that end in -a are feminine and describe girls.

Maria es simpática.

Add -s to the end of most nouns to show that they are plural.

The same thing is true for many adjectives in Spanish.

Los chicos son huenos.

Los chicos son bárdos.
Las chicas son atléticas

Ends in -r? Add -es to make it plural.

The Verb Ser

Ser is a verb that means “to be.” It refers to permanent or lasting conditions, and can it be used in many situations including the following:

- To describe what someone looks like
 - To say what someone's job is
 - To describe someone's personality

Ser is not used to describe feelings, locations, or any condition that is not lasting.

Conversation

¿Cómo eres?
What are you like?

Yo soy + adjetivo.
I am + adjective

¿Cómo es él/ella?

What is he/she like?

Él/Ella es + adjetivo.
He/She is + adjective

Subject Pronouns + Ser (to be)	
yo soy (I am)	nosotros SOMOS (we are) masc. nosotras SOMOS (we are) fem.
tú eres (you are - informal)	
él es (he is)	ellos SON (they are) masc.
ella es (she is)	ellas SON (they are) fem.
usted es (you are - formal)	ustedes SON (you all are)
